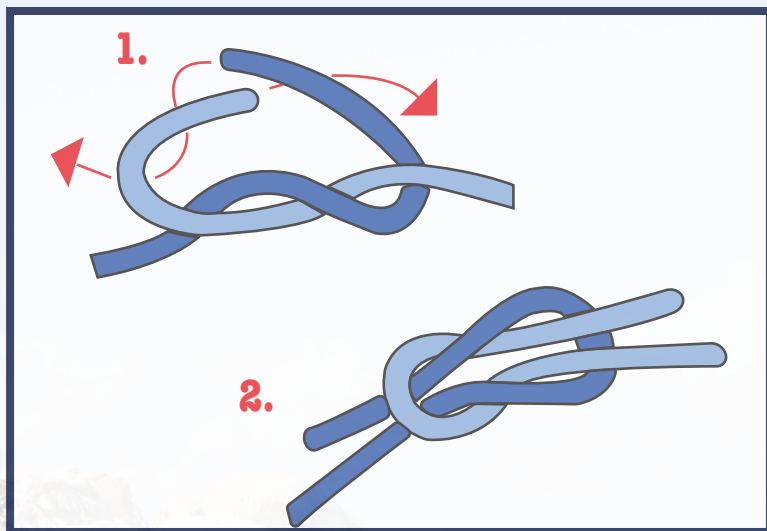

This knot forms a secure loop, easy to tie and untie.

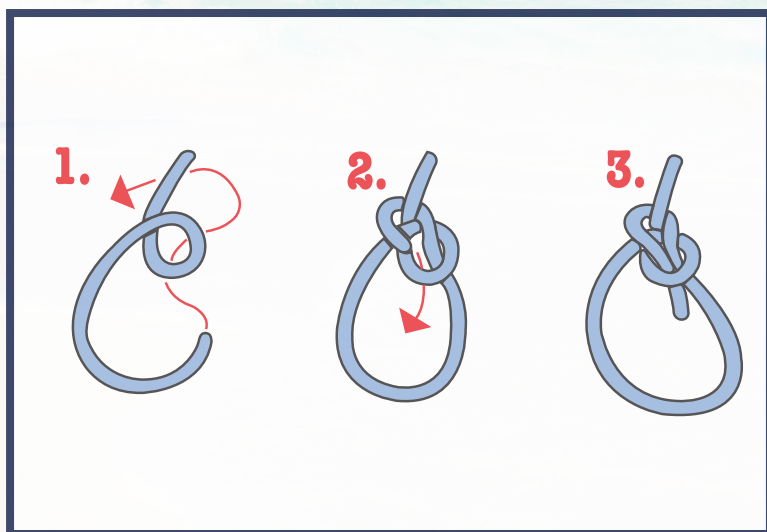
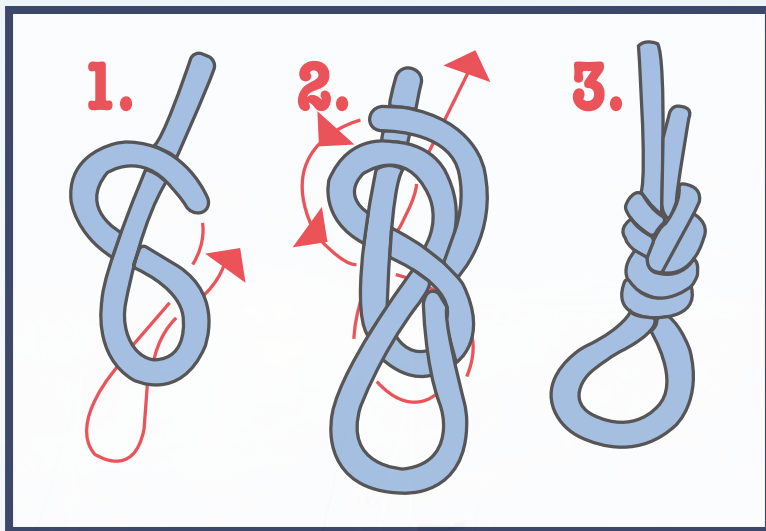


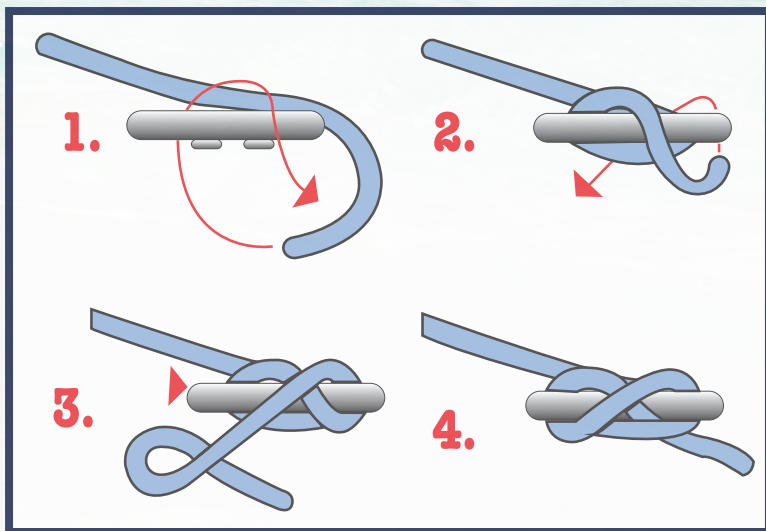
